# March 19, 2017 Sermon Discussion Guide Rev. Steve DeNeff "An Other Priority"

### Gathering

"Lord, may this scripture guide our discussion as well as our lives. Grant us focus and determination to set our eyes toward You as THE priority in our lives."

# Psalm 25:1-7

<sup>1</sup> In you, Lord my God, I put my trust. <sup>2</sup> I trust in you; do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me. <sup>3</sup>No one who hopes in you will ever be put to shame, but shame will come on those who are treacherous without cause. <sup>4</sup>Show me your ways, Lord, teach me your paths. <sup>5</sup> Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long. <sup>6</sup> Remember, Lord, your great mercy and love, for they are from of old. <sup>7</sup> Do not remember the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways; according to your love remember me, for you, Lord, are good.

## Prayer

- For peace in our world. Lord, hear our prayer.
- For a way forward in hope. Lord, hear our prayer.
- For You to be THE priority in our lives. *Lord, hear our prayer.*

#### Scripture

Take the time to read aloud the scripture that was preached. Luke 9:57-62

<sup>57</sup> As they were walking along the road, a man said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go."
<sup>58</sup> Jesus replied, "Foxes have dens and birds have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head."
<sup>59</sup> He said to another man, "Follow me."

But he replied, "Lord, first let me go and bury my father."

<sup>60</sup> Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and proclaim the kingdom of God."

<sup>61</sup> Still another said, "I will follow you, Lord; but first let me go back and say goodbye to my family."

<sup>62</sup> Jesus replied, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God."

## **Major Sermon Discussion Points**

- Talk about the "junk drawer" in your house. What's in it? How did those things get in the drawer? Why haven't those things found other places to be stored?
- Does your schedule seem like a junk drawer? Do you suffer from the "tyranny of the small things?" or did clutter in your life build up one commitment at a time?
- What do you think about the idea that "you can't serve two masters" isn't just spiritual talk but is actually impossible? What masters are you currently trying to serve?
- Try the "Pyramid of Priorities" exercise. Start with 4 "blocks" of the most important things in your life at the bottom and then work your way to the top of the pyramid by removing one block at a time. What came out as your top priority?
- What are your reactions to Pastor Steve's evaluation of the 3 disciples who came to Jesus in this passage?
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Disciple Priority is comfort and security
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Disciple Priority is allegiance/obligation to parents
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Disciple Priority is family
- To which of these disciples do you most relate?
- When thinking about how to make following Christ the top priority, the question of "how?" is answered with "yes." We find a way to figure out the things that are important to us. What is your response to this?

### Next Steps/Moving Forward

- Are you willing to make following Christ the top priority in your life? Will His way become the guide for how you interact with everything else?
- What are some steps you can take to begin to live this way?

#### **Closing Prayer**

Pray as you feel led as a group following your discussion or pray the following prayer individually or together:

#### (from Romans 12:1-2)

In view of Your mercy, God, I offer my body as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to You—this is my true and proper worship. I will not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of my mind. Then I will be able to test and approve what Your will is—Your good, pleasing and perfect will. **Amen.**
